

COMPETITION RULES – AUTOMATION SKILLS GAME

Event Title: FactoryTalk Optix Automation Speed Challenge

Location: A+R Expo 2026, Metropolitan Expo, Athens Greece

Organizer: EDGE Greece

1. Purpose of the Game

The Automation Speed Challenge is designed to test participants' memory, precision, and speed in reproducing a sequence of colors.

2. Eligibility

- The competition is open to all registered attendees of the fair.
- Participants must be at least 18 years old.
- Employees of the organizing company may participate but are not eligible for prizes.

3. Game Description

- Each participant will be shown a sequence of colors on a screen or device.
- The sequence will be displayed for 10 seconds only.
- After the sequence disappears, the participant must reproduce the exact same sequence using the provided interface or equipment.
- The goal is to complete the sequence as quickly and accurately as possible.

4. Timing and Ranking

- Timing starts immediately after the color sequence disappears.
- Timing ends when the participant completes and confirms their sequence.
- Only correctly reproduced sequences will be considered valid.
- Participants will be ranked based on the fastest valid completion time.
- Incorrect sequences will result in disqualification for that attempt.

5. Prizes

- The top 5 participants with the fastest valid completion times will each receive:
 - n1 Micro820 Controller by Rockwell Automation
- Prizes are non-transferable and cannot be exchanged for cash or other items.

6. Rules of Conduct

- Participants must follow all instructions given by event staff.
- No external assistance, devices, or recording tools are allowed during the game.
- Any attempt to cheat will result in immediate disqualification.
- Participants must use only the equipment provided.

7. Attempts

- Each participant is allowed one attempt, unless otherwise stated by the organizers.
- In case of technical malfunction, a new attempt may be granted at the organizers' discretion.

8. Safety

- Participants must follow all safety guidelines provided at the event.
- The organizer is not responsible for any injury caused by misuse of equipment.

9. Organizer Rights

- The organizer reserves the right to modify the rules, schedule, or format if necessary.
- All decisions made by the organizers are final and binding.

10. Acceptance of Rules

Participation in the game implies full acceptance of these rules.
